

ARE YOU DISABLED AND/OR ELDERLY AND NOT RECEIVING MEDI-CAL BENEFITS?

If you are aged (65+) or disabled and are not eligible for the SSI program, you may be able to get Medi-Cal through the **Aged & Disabled Federal Poverty Level** program, which provides free, full scope Medi-Cal services for disabled or aged individuals who meet income and asset requirements of the program.

You may be eligible for Medi-Cal with no share of cost if you meet the following requirements:

- You must be disabled and/or elderly (65 years or older);
- Your countable income must be \$1,583 monthly or less if you are single or \$2,126 monthly or less if you are a couple¹, and;
- Your liquid resources must be less than \$2,000 if you are an individual and less than \$3,000 if you are a couple²

If your monthly income exceeds the above amounts you may still want to sign up for Medi-Cal, but you will have a share of cost. See our information sheet about Medi-Cal Share of Cost.

HOW DO I SIGN UP?

¹ Medi-Cal applies certain deductions when determining countable income, so some income may not count toward this limit.

² These dollar amounts reflect 2022 but changes yearly. Note: as of July 1, 2022, asset limits will increase for all programs below except SSI -- Single: \$130,000; Couple: \$195,000
